President Benton called the meeting of Homestead Borough Council to order at 6:07 p.m. on May 14, 2020 via telephone conference due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Roll Call- Those present for roll call were Mr. Borcik, Ms. Burwell, Min. Burwell, Mr. Cunningham and President Benton. Also present for the meeting were Mayor Esper, Solicitor Heminger, Manager Zang. Absent from the meeting were Mr. Dais and Ms. Nesby.

### Motions

1. A motion was made by Mr. Borcik and seconded by Ms. Burwell to approve the May 6, 2020 Bill List in the amount of \$95,122.93 having removed the invoices from AW Construction in the amount of \$4,200. Upon a roll call vote all were in favor, motion carries.
2. A motion was made by Mr. Cunningham and seconded by Mr. Borcik to approve a Certificate of Appropriateness for sign upgrades for Valero Oil on property located at 238 East 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, with the condition that the landscaping plan from the previous approval be installed, as recommended by the Steel Valley Historic Architectural Review Board on May 6, 2020. Upon a roll call vote all present were in favor except for Ms. Burwell, motion carries 4-1.
3. REMOVED from agenda-Motion to advertise an Ordinance drafted by the Solicitor for parking in alleys.
4. A motion was made by Mr. Cunningham and seconded by Min. Burwell to direct the Solicitor to amend the language in the Propel Parking Ordinance to address parking on both sides of the street. Upon a roll call vote all were in favor, motion carries.
5. A motion was made by Mr. Borcik and seconded by Mr. Cunningham to approve the wire transfer of funds in the amount of \$5,102.00 to the bank account of JMPolicedogs located in the Netherlands for the

purchase of the new canine police dog for the Homestead Police Department with grant funds received from the Ben Roethlisberger Foundation. Upon a roll call vote all were in favor, motion carries.

The meeting was adjourned by President Benton at 6:16pm
